The Fishers Pond common strain and the mirror strain were crossed by John Paton three years ago and the resulting offspring saw a large percentage of the youngsters covered in scales. These fish averaging 5 lb 8 oz were stocked out in March 2011 and will be available as 4 summer fish at 8 lb to 11 lb in November 2011.

## **ABOUT HEATHER FISHERIES**

Mark Simmonds is the sole proprietor of Heather Fisheries with 34 years experience in fish farming and management of specialist carp fisheries and commercial coarse fisheries. The fish Heather Fisheries supply are all top quality young healthy unfished for stock from fish farm sites in Hampshire, Wiltshire and Dorset and I pride myself in the belief that the fish supplied by me are of the highest quality and will give my customers years of tremendous value.

### **THE STRAIN**

The carp supplied by Heather Fisheries are Fishers Pond strain supplied by John Paton of Fishers Pond Fishery at various stages of their lives. The strain is without doubt the most recognised fastest growing available in the U.K and are the most widely stocked carp in the countries leading waters.

### **GROWTH RATES**

Carp will only grow to the capability of the water they are stocked into. Size of the venue, amount of carp in the water, available food and part of the country the venue is located in all dramatically influence growth rates. Amazing growth rates in Southern based gravel pits which are very lightly stocked have been achieved with up to 7 lb plus in a year, however the average is around 3 lb. In the North of England average growth would be more like 2 lb. Fishery managers and syndicate bosses are more and more becoming aware of the tremendous influence supplementary feeding can have on the growth of their stock. I am always available for advice on supplementary feeding and can also supply top quality feed that our carp are reared on at trade prices.

### **WHY PURCHASE OUR STOCK**

In today's day and age stocking new fish into waters can be a minefield and very often expensive mistakes can be made by putting the wrong stock into a water or stock of a dubious nature that can kill your existing stock. With years of experience in all aspects of stocking I can advise my customers on the best type of fish and sizes to stock into their waters to give them the best results and benefit their fisheries long term. We don't deal in other peoples unwanted stocks and we don't do outside netting work minimising the risks of our fish picking up diseases. What's more all of our fish are of a known age so you can be sure you know exactly what you are buying. A large percentage of the stock offered for sale in the UK are supplied by dealers who net fish from here, there and everywhere and take them back to holding farms where they are mixed together before being sold on. The 5 lb carp you have just purchased may look fine when it arrives and may be £1.00 per lb cheaper than a Heather Fisheries supplied fish but for all you know it could be 15 years old from a farm pond and might never grow, where as you know the three summer carp you have purchased from Heather Fisheries is exactly that. It has been picked out as the fastest growing percentage of its year class, and it will grow to the potential of the food source available. Ten years after stocking your dealer purchased fish might still be 5 lb or even worse dead while your Heather Fisheries fish could be a mid thirty. The same applies to all our bream, crucians, roach and tench. They are all young and fast growing farmed fish not somebody else's cast offs.

## **HOW OUR FISH ARE GROWN**

The carp are all spawned in a hatchery by John Paton at Fishers Pond artificially and then put out into specially prepared fry ponds. At 12 months old the best growers are grown on in a three acre pond then at two years transferred into a ten acre pond on the main site at Fishers Pond. At three years the best growers are moved to a ten acre Heather Fisheries outside, while at five years the biggest fish get moved into various Heather Fisheries outsites which vary in size up to ten acres. All the fish produced are reared under natural conditions and their natural diet is supplemented with a quality trout pellet. None of our fish are grown in indoor warm water systems which is becoming a very unhealthy trend by other fish farmers who are producing fish at up to 10 lb in two years but these fish survive poorly when stocked and their weights plunge. Be warned about the increasing amount of these fish on the market.

## **MALE TO FEMALE RATIOS**

When buying four year carp the ratio of females to males can be as high as 80% females, while in older year classes it can be as high as 90%. If you are stocking with four year or larger fish into a new water or a water with very few carp it is important to let us know so we can make sure there are enough males in your batch to make sure the females don't become spawn bound and die prematurely. Males on the whole are slower growing but do live longer than females and we are growing on an increasing number of our best males to 20 lb plus. Nearly half of this year's production of 19 lb plus fish are males.

## **WHEN RECEIVING YOUR STOCK**

It doesn't matter how careful we are at harvesting your carp they will always pick up superficial fin and scale damage during harvesting and transport but the damage will be superficial and will quickly heal. On the day of receiving your stock if you want to photo all of your carp please be organised with cameras unhooking mats etc (it's worth noting digital cameras don't like very cold conditions). We suggest you number large white envelopes with the numbers of the amount of fish you are having and have a black felt tip pen on the day to put the weight alongside the number of the fish. Please make sure you have enough people to make the stocking go as smoothly as possible. After starting out on most deliveries at 4.00 am we would appreciate your help in being on time to receive your fish and being organised to save as much time on the delivery as possible.

## **ADVICE ALWAYS AVAILABLE**

I am always available on the end of a phone to give free advice on all matters relating to carp stockings and all aspects of coarse fishery management whether you are an existing customer or not. Please feel free to utilise my experience as it may save you a lot of money or heartache long term.

## HOW ARE THEY DOING NOW

John Patons Fishers Pond strain of carp are without doubt the leading strain in the country and have a proven track record with our fish gracing the angling papers on a weekly basis and not only that they have an excellent catch rate and will feed in extreme winter conditions with over a thousand thirties, more than a hundred forties and now 11 fifties and I confidently predict that 5 years from now we could be looking at as many as 50 fish over 50 lb in the UK from our stockies. Where else to start this year but with the mighty Half Linear from Vinetrow which set a Sussex record when landed at a massive 54 lb 10 oz when caught by Dave Comber. The fish will be 18 years old next June.

Kevin Nash's Church Pool holds several fish over 50 lb that have grown on amazingly with the excellent fishing management and quality bait that Kevin puts into the venue. Justin Grapes took one of our stockies at 52 lb 3 oz this year and the fish looks likely to grow into a legendary fish.

Another one of our fifty pound plus fish lives in the Charity Lake at Lenwade with Baby Face. Ian Dowe took the fish at 51 lb for a lake record. Baby Face will be 18

years old next June and is a sibling to the Horton and Monks Pool fish on the Isle of Wight.

Paul and Sue Wards Grenvilles Lake at Huntingdon looks set to become one of the most legendary carp waters of all time and holds an astonishing 300 fish over 30 lb with no less than 11 different 40 lb plus fish and more amazingly the first fish I stocked wasn't until November 2003. The lake record recently went to Gary Mills who took an incredible fish with a 46 lb 5 oz mirror that was stocked at 12 lb in November 2003.

Unbelievably Two Tone that was caught at 43 lb 8 oz by Max Cottis was stocked in January 2005 at just 5 lb so has put on 38 lb 8 oz of growth in just 6.5 years and the fish won't be 10 years old until next June and looks set to be an absolute monster in years to come. Grenvilles has been a remarkable success story and shows what can be achieved with the right fish in the right water.

Just down the road from Grenvilles is Mike Richardson's Monks Pit which is full of our stockies which have done exceptionally well with the first fifty from the venue. Simon Harbottle took Porky at a magnificent 51 lb 1 oz around 4 lb up on its previous best weight and was stocked at 5 lb in 1999 and won't be 15 years old until June next year.

Monks holds over 70 of our fish at over 30 lb and some nice forties that are following Porky up the weights. Wayne Littles Milton Abbas Lake has literally hundreds of twenties, numerous thirties and 4 of our stockies over 40 lb. Without doubt everyone's target fish at Milton is the Baby Common caught at a massive 47 lb 8 oz by Greg Alexander. Baby will be 17 years old next June and is a sibling to the Cotswold Water Park commons that have been out just over 50 lb and also a sibling to the Dovecotte commons up to 46 lb and the Monks Pool fish to 42 lb 9 oz.

Two new fish over 40 lb from Milton this year were Bloater at 40 lb 10 oz by Martin Brent and Neil Mitchell with the Preety Fish at 40 lb 3 oz, while Martin Bowler had Houndini at 43 lb 4 oz.

Another water on the up with plenty of our stockies is Wazeing and that excellent angler Jamie Walker took The Simmo at an all time high of 47 lb, while Phil the fish Court had numerous 30 lb plus stockies last year.

Next to The Isle of Wight where most of the fish have been back in weight this year. It's unbelievable that Monks Pool with 6 different forties and a stack of upper thirties rarely sees an angler or any bait!! Spencer Wright however had another excellent season on Monks landing The Boxer at 45 lb 13 oz, The Leather at 42 lb 6 oz, The Spring Common at 42 lb 7 oz. Hopefully with a bit more bait the Monks legends which are 17 and 18 years old may get back to their previous higher weights. Tim Oatleys Blackwater Syndicate is very much a water with a growing reputation for loads of thirties including some magnificent commons with a new lake record common known as Simmos Common at 37 lb 6 oz. While the biggest fish of the year was Floppy Tail at 39 lb 10 oz to Steve Kitcher.

Blackwater was stocked with 3 and 4 summer carp in 2002 and looks to be another success story for The Islands Governor of carp Tim Oatley who also runs Monks Pool and day ticket venue Rookley Park. Rookley had another exceptional year and the tiny 2 acre water holds 146 carp over 20 lb including a host of thirties and a brace of forties with Milly and Rosie being out at 40 lb plus in the last 12 months. Another water on The Island full of our stockies is Will Groves Combley Main Lake and Trout Lake. The Trout Lake which produced an island record at 48 lb 8 oz to Steve Renyard hasn't been fished much in the last 12 months with the main lake receiving much of the angling pressure. Among some of the forties has been Dean Brookes with The Bruiser at 41 lb 2 oz, Andy Loaring with a 40 lb 12 oz and Jason Merrin with a 40 lb 12 oz.

The Combley fish were stocked at 5 lb in 2003 and are siblings to the Grenvilles fish and the original Brasenose1 fish.

Next to The Cemex waters where the Kingsmead 1 record went when Starry came out at 45 lb 8 oz and looks certain to be another fifty pound fish from our stockies in years to come.

Steve Newman took another Kingsmead fish at 44 lb 15 oz and this looks another fish set to go all the way. Both fish were stocked at 10 lb and the fish will be 17 years old next June. Cemex Horton has a stack of our fish at 30 lb plus and an increasing number of forties. Hercules is one fish definitely on the move and has been out at 45 lb, while another fish on the march is Fingers which has been out at weights to 43 lb 3 oz.

Cemex Pads Lake and Sandhurst both have stacks of our fish at over 30 lb while Cemex Apex looks set to be a phenomenal twenties water over the next few years while Chigborough and the Road Lake are waters to watch out for as is Chertsey. Westhampnett at Chichester has done Fishers Pond fish to 44 lb and I've put some very nice 4 summer fish in there in recent years which are going to be very big fish.

Another water certain to produce one of our fish at over 50 lb is Des Rambridges Dovecotte Lake which produced a magnificent 45 lb 8 oz mirror to break the fishery record when landed by Carl Sharp. The fish is a sibling to the Monks Pool, Vinetrow

and Horton fish. Dovecotte also holds several of our commons over 40 lb with the best just short of 46 lb. Medbury Lane Lake in Bedford saw one of our fish go through the 40 lb mark when Clive Bates took a 41 lb 8 oz mirror. Medbury also holds some of the original Fishers Pond ghosties to mid thirties.

Talking of ghosties and Jason Davis and Tinkers syndicate water Nunnery holds probably one of the countries biggest ghosties at 44 lb and the fish has great length and shoulders and can be the countries first 50 lb ghostie.

Jason and Tinkers Nunnery and West Stow holds a heap of our stockies including numerous thirties and some nice forties and stock their venues each year with a handful of our best 4 and 5 summer fish.

The very first time I saw Mitch Rayners The Rise in Essex before it had a fish put in I knew it was going to be a very very special water and it's another Manor waiting to happen. Mitch stocked the venue with a mixture of 4, 5 and 6 summer carp and they have done exceptionally well in no time at all with a new lake record to Paul Welch with Rosebud at 39 lb 7 oz.

Staying in Essex The Manor has several of our fish over the 40 lb mark from a stocking of 4 summer fish which are siblings to the Horton and Monks Pool fish. Last autumn I stocked 4 sensational 5 summer commons just short of 20 lb into The Manor and keep a look out for these fish in the future they will be very very big fish. Another Essex venue stacked with our fish with a massive head of twenties and some thirties plus now a 40 lb is Steve Hayes Berners Hall. The Glitter Fish is a stunning looking fish and set a new fishery best at 40 lb 2 oz when landed by Steve Hawkes. The Glitter Fish was stocked in 2003 at 12 lb. Steve also has another fish 2 years younger called the Match Mirror which was stocked in 2004 at 5 lb and has been out at 36 lb this year and will be challenging The Glitter Fish in years to come. I stocked some fabulous 3 summer Fishers Pond scalys into Berners Hall last year and I have high hopes for them.

Another Essex venue with our stockies is Kenny Gates Golden Gates which have suddenly started to really pile the weight on and it can't be long before it does its first Fishers Pond forty.

John Wilkins has put his heart and sole into his season ticket venue Leverets Lake and it's turned into a cracking water which only has Fishers Pond stockies in it. The lake record went this year when Mark Tripp took The Blue One at 36 lb 7 oz to depose Little Brother, however I have a feeling a fish called Shaker that has been out at 34 lb 11 oz will be the first Leverets 40 lb. The lake also did its first 30 lb common this year with Speck at 31 lb 12 oz.

One person who couldn't have put more effort possibly into setting up a fishery is Joe Jarman with his Broadoak Fishery in Kent, the venue saw a new lake record when Mark Hollands landed Alice at a fantastic weight of 44 lb 10 oz. Alice has some great length and is another Fishers Pond fifty in the waiting. Broadoak also has three fabulous commons that rarely show but any day now one of them is going to be caught at over 40 lb. The Venue has an incredible 40 thirties and over 60 upper twenties from our stock.

John Candy's Big Hayes and Little Hayes have become extremely popular with loads of up and coming stockies racing through to the 20 lb mark and I confidently predict

in 5 years time both venues will be fantastic twenties/thirties waters. Big Hayes has recently done its first 30 lb for quite a while, while Little Hayes has done fish to 28 lb and specimen lake Paddock fish to 29 lb 5 oz. One of Mr Candy's down falls is his love of ghosties and he hasn't been able to resist the odd big fish I have had available over the years and this year both Big Hayes and Little Hayes have produced cracking ghosties that look set to go all the way. Ben Scouse with Little Hayes record ghostie Fishers Pond Ghostie at 23 lb, while Ian Hentschell took Simmos Ghostie at 24 lb 2 oz to set the Big Hayes ghostie record.

Oxford Linears waters certainly must hold a minimum of a hundred of our stockies over 30 lb and probably over a thousand 20 lb plus fish. It's been a great year at Linear with Brasenose 1 producing fish over 30 lb on a daily basis. While Brasenose 2 is now producing fish to 33 lb. Fishery Manager Chris Blunt reports that Oxlease has had an excellent year with stacks of thirties and it won't be long before Oxlease does its first forty.

The Cotswold water Park has some true whackers including a 51 lb mirror from Bradleys and at least one other 50 lb from a private syndicate water. Bradleys also has some monster commons to mid forties which are siblings to the Milton, Dovecote and Monks Pool commons. Andy Stumps Wildmoor Water and several South Cerney waters hold plenty of our stockies which are pushing on up to the 30 lb mark. Moving into The West Country and Andy Serrys Stafford Moor produced a new lake record with Scaly at 33 lb while both Beatties and Josephs are rammed with upper doubles and twenties. Kev Harman's mid Cornwall Fishery is very much an up and coming water with over 50 of our stockies at over 20 lb and thirties are just around the corner. In Wales Vince Lloyds White Springs is stacked with our stockies and the first Simmo forty was caught this year, with plenty of other fish in the upper twenty to mid thirty bracket. Bryn Bach Park is another water very much on the up and a sensible stocking programme has seen plenty of young fish following the originals through. The Birch is another water full of our stockies that are going places. Back into Essex and Fryerning Fishery run by Chris Knowles has produced some nice 40 lb plus fish from our stockies including the record at 44 lb 2 oz. Another Essex venue which I'm sure is going to produce some very big fish is Colemans Lake and although I've seen reports of fish to 35 lb 6 oz I'm sure it's done bigger fish. Mid Kent Fisheries have our stockies in several of their waters with fish to over 40 lb from Chilham, while Fishery Manager Chris Logsdone took a big batch of 6 summer fish between 19 lb and 21 lb that are going places in several other mid Kent waters. Woking and District Lakes hold some nice fish from our stockies between mid twenties and mid thirties. While Farnham and Districts The Tarn has produced several different thirties this year. Moving to The Midlands and Baden Hall has seen our fish out to 35 lb plus this year, while several syndicate waters have our fish to over 40 lb. It's not just Southern waters where our fish grow with Raker Lakes at York full of our fish over 20 lb with several thirties. While further North The Aldermere Syndicate, The Wainstone Syndicate and Lonsdale Park also have some cracking Fishers Pond fish. The list of waters around the country is endless and we are proud to include Colchester and District, St Georges Lake, Dartford and District, Warrington A.C, Ringwood and District, Christchurch and District, Stream Valleys, Waveney Valleys, Llyn-Y-Gors, Kenny Gates, Tom Banks, Withy Pool, Bathampton A.C, Wheelock A.C, Longleat Estate, Broadlands Lakes, Wentworth Estate, Carp Vale doubles, T.V.A.C, Salisbury and District and Cefn Mabley Lakes to name just a few where you will find our stockies.

## ABOUT THE CARP

All the carp supplied by Heather Fisheries are from M.A.F.F registered fish farm sites in Hampshire, Wiltshire and Dorset and are guaranteed unfished for stock of the highest quality. The fish are health checked on a regular basis and subject to M.A.F.F conditions. All the fish are from a strain of carp developed over the years that is recognised as one of the fastest growing available in the UK the fish have never been or ever will be in contact with foreign carp whilst under my control.

**Two Summer Carp** availability October 2011 to February 2012. Size 1 lb to 1 lb 8 oz. These fish are all mirrors and have plenty of scales with a good length. The biggest 5% at 4 inches to 5 inches were stocked out April 2011. Suitable to be stocked into stock ponds or lakes with no other or very few carp and no predators (pike or cormorants). Will do best in specially prepared or virgin lakes where they are the only fish present. Not suitable to be stocked into densely stocked carp fisheries.

**Three Summer Carp** for match and pleasure fisheries, availability October 2011 to February 2012 size 2 lb 8 oz to 4 lb. Just about the only thing to stock into cormorant ravaged clear weedy club lakes. Numerous venues have been turned round after being stocked at rates of around 250 lb per acre. Will mix with larger carp, the batch consist of all mirrors that are lightly scaled. If you want to reduce weed and keep anglers happy, the no.1 fish to stock.

**Three Summer Carp for specialist fisheries** availability January 2012 to February 2012, size 4 lb to 6 lb. This cracking batch of scaly mirrors are the best 5,000 out of an original 300,000 making them 1 in 60 special. By crossing the Fishers Pond mirror strain with the Fishers Pond common strain the resulting offspring have grown on a par up to this stage as previous year classes which have had few scales. They have been stocked out at 2 lb in April 2011 and are suitable to be stocked directly into fisheries or grown on, on their own. I have experienced pike predation on three summer fish when stocked into waters where cormorants have decimated shoal fish, but normally they are fairly predator safe, but you have been warned.

**Four Summer Carp** availability November 2011 to December 2011 size 8 lb to 11 lb. This batch is 90 % mirrors which are covered in large apple slice scales. These fish have a great length and good shoulders . They were stocked out at 5 lb to 6 lb in March 2011. Four summer carp will make twenties in two to three years in the right waters and are generally the most advised fish to stock into specialist carp fisheries.

**Five Summer Carp** availability October 2011 to February 2012 size 14 lb to 18 lb. The commons from this batch are magnificent and look set to become some of the country's biggest fish with great length and shoulders. They are well in advance at this stage of previous year classes that are taking the country by storm with forties from Bedford, Essex, Colne Valley, Cotswold Water Park, Dorset and The Isle of Wight. The mirrors have a good length and are lightly scaled and in the right water these fish will quickly go on to make thirties.

**Six Summer Carp** availability October 2011 to February 2012 size 19 lb to 22 lb 15 oz. These are the very best carp and only 1 in a 1000 is grown on to this stage. I can safely say there is nothing in the UK that comes in even close to the quality or size at this age.

**Seven Summer Plus Carp** availability October 2011 to February 2012 size 23 lb to 27 lb15 oz. Due to having to shut several of our biggest out sites to otter predation I can now only supply a very limited number of carp over 23 lb and these need to be ordered well in advance. Larger fish that 27 lb 15 oz are no longer available.

1. All orders must be received in writing and will be confirmed in writing by Heather Fisheries.
2. Fish will only be supplied with an FR 1 consent from the Environment Agency. Heather Fisheries will take care of the necessary paperwork on your behalf for a charge of £15.00. Health certificates will be provided to the Environment Agency.
3. No guarantee can be taken to supply the whole order with the size of fish as requested, but orders are accepted on the terms that given normal growing conditions and bar disasters the fish you have ordered will be available. Any shortfalls in numbers or size will be notified to you well before delivery so you can make a decision whether you still want the fish.
4. Delivery of fish will be notified at least one week in advance.
5. All fish will be weighed on delivery and you will be charged the agreed price per lb to the nearest quarter of a pound.
6. When fish are supplied by the inch customers are encourage to count them into their fishery.
7. Heather Fisheries guarantees the health and condition of the fish to your fishery. On arrival you will be asked if you are happy with the fish. They will then be weighed or counted into your fishery and you will be asked to sign for them.
8. Once the fish leave the delivery tank and are in your waters and accepted by you then they become your responsibility and no claims can be made against Heather Fisheries under any circumstances in the future.
